8 January 2009	Closing Date Team Event. Payment of Team Entry Fee to ESF (€134 per Team). Payment of 25% standard package costs to host (€614 per team based on 7 people in multiple rooms); or Payment of 25% basic package to host (€180 per team based on 7 people).
28 February 2009	Payment of 75% balance of standard package costs to host (€1.843 per team based on 7 people in multiple rooms); or Payment of 75% balance of basic package costs to host (€541 per team based on 7 people).
4 March 2009	Deadline for notification by MNAs of accommodation requirements. Closing Date Individual Event. Payment of Individual Entry Fees (€10 per player) to Host Association plus: Payment of 100% Individual standard package costs to host (€351 per person); or Payment of 100% Individual basic package costs to host (€77 per person). Supply the names of players in the teams in descending order of strength. Supply a photograph and a short biography of all participants. Closing Date for Travel Details
20 March 2009	MNAs receive the draw of the Individual Championships.
3 April 2009	Arrival Day.
4 April 2009	Start Date Individual Championships. Managers' & Coaches' meeting.
5 April 2009	Changes to Squad Orders may be lodged with the Championships Director.
6 April 2009	Seeding Panel seeds teams.
7 April 2009	Finals of Individual Championships.
8 April 2009	Rest Day. Organisers will offer sightseeing tours.
9 April 2009	Start Date Team Championship.
12 April 2009	Final of Team Championship.
13 April 2009	Departure Day.

ENTRIES / ENTRY FEES

Only official entry forms which are endorsed by Member National Associations will be accepted. These forms must be sent to both the Organisers and the European Squash Federation.

The entry fee for the Team Championships is € 134 per team. The entry fee for the Individual Championships is € 10 per player.

The entry fees must be paid net of bank charges at the time of entry.

Closing date Team Championship: 8 January 2009

Entries must be made on the official entry forms.

If more than 24 teams enter the event, the basis of acceptance shall be decided by the ESF Officers on a 'first come, first served' basis. All entries will be acknowledged and forms for hotel booking and travel information will be sent to the participating MNAs.

Closing date Individual Championships: 4 March 2009

Each MNA shall have the right to enter **4 girls** and **4 boys** in the Individual Events provided they meet the eligibility criteria defined in Rule C3 (except, in the unlikely event that more than 64 Entries are received in either event, when the ESF Technical Director will reduce numbers at his discretion).

Each MNA may seek to enter no more than 2 additional players in each event. These players will be put on Reserve Lists and may be added to the draw at the discretion of the ESF Technical Director if there are less than 64 entries. If there are still less than 64 entries in either event 21 days before the Start Date then draws may be filled by players of lower strength from the Host MNA.

LATE ENTRIES & WITHDRAWALS

No late entries will be accepted in the Team or Individual Championships.

The ESF shall impose a penalty fee, additional to the entry fee, to cover additional costs incurred when an MNA withdraws a team from the Championships (Rule A11). The penalty fees are:

Withdrawal 60 days or more before the Start Date	100% of Entry Fee per team
Withdrawal 30 to 59 days before the Start Date	200% of Entry Fee per team
Withdrawal less than 30 days before the Start Date	300% of Entry Fee per team.

The Host Association also reserves the right to retain the 25% deposit for accommodation should a team withdraw or should a member of a squad or associated official withdraw without being replaced.

The ESF shall impose a penalty fee of € 45 and the MNA shall forfeit the €10 entry fee when a MNA withdraws an individual from either of the Individual Championships less than 30 days before the Start Date (Rule A11).

ELIGIBILITY

Teams shall represent MNAs of the ESF which have settled all financial obligations by the closing date of entry to the Championships and have not been prohibited from entering the Team Event under the provisions of the Code of Conduct or for any other reason. Participating nations must be Full Members. Players are eligible to represent an MNA provided they satisfy the criteria laid down in ESF Rule C3.

All players in the Individual Events shall be under the age of 19 years on the final scheduled day of the Individual Championships (7 April 2009).

SEEDING OF TEAMS

The ESF Seeding Panel will seed teams in the presence of the CAP during the afternoon on the day of the Semi-Finals of the Individual Events (6 April 2009), based on the current form and order of the players nominated in each team. If there is no significant difference in the strength of up to 4 teams, then the relative seeding of these teams will be done by lot.

THE VENUE

Germering is a neighbouring town to the west of Munich.

TOURNAMENT PACKAGE

Accommodation can only be booked through the organisers of the EJC 2009 (Squash in Bayern).

The Hotel is situated 1.5 km from Munich main railway station, 2 km from the centre of Munich, 40 km from Munich airport, 13 km from the venue.

The standard package price is € 351 per person per event including accommodation in multiple bedded rooms and breakfast at the Hotel and all other meals at the venue, transportation to and from the railway station/airport and organisation costs. The package for the Individual Event starts with dinner on 3 April and ends with breakfast on 8 April; the package for the Team Event starts with dinner on 8 April and ends with breakfast on 13 April. Participants staying for both events will be provided with a lunch package or a meal voucher on 8 April. Additional nights are € 52 per person in a multiple bedded room per night (excluding food). A limited number of single rooms are available at an extra charge of € 31 per person per night.

The basic package price is € 103 per person for the Team Event and € 77 per person for the Individual Event, for those that wish to make their own arrangements for local transport, accommodation and food. This package fee covers organisation of the event, a welcome pack,

admission to all court viewing areas and, for those in the Team Event, a final evening party/function.

The Host Association is responsible for providing a package for a maximum of 7 people per squad (including reserves and officials) in the Team event and for competing players in the Individual Events starting from the evening dinner before the Start Date and ending with breakfast on the morning following the finals for each Event.

(The Host Association is not obliged to help find or provide accommodation, offer “packages” or provide local transport for supporters but may do so if approached directly by an MNA, provided priority is given to nominated players and officials.)

MNAs must send 25% (€ 614 / € 180) of the Package Fee for the Team Event to the Bavarian Squash Federation as a deposit for accommodation by the closing date. The remaining 75% must be paid to the Bavarian Squash Federation not later than 28 February 2009. If the balance is not paid by this date, the initial 25% is forfeited and the entry shall be cancelled. Unless advised otherwise, the Host Association will assume that the MNA requires the full package for the Team for 5 nights.

The full Package Fee for the Individual Event must be paid to the Bavarian Squash Federation not later than Wednesday, 4 March 2009.

All packages must be paid net of bank charges.

TRANSPORT

- Teams and Individuals arriving at Munich Railway Main Station will be met on arrival if the organisers receive travel details by 4 March.
For those arriving by air the train service between the airport and the city centre provides the quickest means of travel. The motorway link is congested, especially during the busy morning and evening commuter periods, and hold ups and delays are to be expected.
- Players leaving after the Individual or Team Event will be dropped off at Munich Railway Main Station.

TIME FRAME

The matches in the Individual Events will be scheduled to commence on Saturday, 4 April 2009 at 10.30 hrs. The matches in the Team Event will be scheduled to commence on Thursday, 9 April 2009 at 10.00 hrs.

It is proposed that the team managers' and coaches' meeting will take place at 08.30 hrs on Saturday, 4 April 2009.

There will be a rest day on Wednesday, 8 April 2009. The organisers will be offering sightseeing opportunities for all participants.

The departure day will be Monday, 13 April 2009.

PLAYING ORDER IN THE TEAM EVENT

The playing order of matches in all Ties on each day of the Championships will be drawn by the CAP at 09:00 hrs on the day of the Semi-Finals of the Individual Events and shall be posted in the Tournament Office and in the official hotel(s).

Team Managers will be advised of the venue of the draw so they may attend if they wish. Details of the playing order shall be posted in the Tournament Office, the official hotel and on the internet.

All Ties played each day will use the same playing order. The #1 boy must play 1st or 2nd – leaving 4 possible playing permutations (1-2-3, 1-3-2, 2-1-3, 3-1-2).

DRAWS

The draws for the Individual event will be sent no later than 14 days before the Start Date to the participating Member National Associations. They will also be published on the tournament website <http://squash-events.de/em09/>

REFEREES

The Bavarian Squash Federation will ensure (through the Championships Referee) that a Referee and Marker officiate at every match in the Team Championship. The Bavarian Squash Federation should provide sufficient qualified referees, but players or officials from the two competing teams in a tie may be asked to mark and referee their matches. Teams must provide markers, as requested by the Championships Referee, who shall present a schedule of requirements at the Managers' Meeting, prior to the start of the Event.

For the Individual Championships, players may be requested to referee and mark up to the last 8 places. The Bavarian Squash Association shall provide qualified referees and markers for all subsequent rounds.

SQUASH BALLS

The Dunlop PRO XX ball will be used.

DRUGS

ESF and the German Squash Federation reserve the right to implement compulsory dope testing for any player participating in the Championships. This event must be drug free. Dope testing may be carried out by the National Government.

EYE-PROTECTION

The use of approved eye-protection is compulsory.

CURRENCY

The EURO is the official currency of the European Squash Federation. All payments to ESF and the host must be made in Euro.

TEAM & SQUAD ORDER

1. MNAs must lodge with the ESF Office at least **30 days** before the Start Date, by post, email or fax, the names of the players in their squads in descending order of strength (keeping Boys and Girls separate). This must reflect the current form of players (e.g. past three months Junior Open and Closed results, Invitation Tournaments etc). Not more than 3 boys and 2 girls may be nominated; and only those players who have been officially nominated may play in any match.

Any squad that has not been lodged correctly by the deadline may be scratched from the Team Championship at the discretion of the ESF Officers and risks being ignored for seeding purposes; and the MNA will be liable for a fine under the Code of Conduct (see Appendix E).

2. MNAs may lodge in writing (by hand, letter, email or fax) with the Championships Director by **21:00 hours** on the day before the Semi-Finals of the Individual Events (the "Final Submission Date"), changes to their squad names, and/or changes to their squad orders justified by changes in current form.
3. The Championships Director will announce all nominations by **09:00 hours** on the day of the Semi-Finals of the Individual Events. Details shall be posted in the Tournament Office, the official hotel(s) and on the internet.
4. Any objections to a playing order or player eligibility must be lodged with the Championships Director by **12:00 hours** on the day of the Semi-Finals of the Individual Events. Objections must be in writing and be justified with evidence such as recent results or rankings.
5. The CAP will scrutinise nominations and will consider any objection lodged with the Championships Director. The CAP reserves the right to amend any squad order without formal objection. Team Managers must be available between 12:00 and 20:00 hours to give evidence to the CAP if required. The Team Manager will be advised immediately if his squad is subject to objection or amendment; or if he is required to justify player eligibility or playing order to the CAP. The CAP will hear his justification with the objecting manager(s) invited to be present. The decision of the CAP will be final.

The Seeding Panel will then do the seeding in line with Rule G2. The Championships Director will announce the seedings and draw by **20:00 hours** on the day of the Semi-Finals of the Individual Events. MNAs have no right of appeal against seeding or draw.

6. The squad playing order must be adhered to throughout the Championships. Any player can be omitted from a Tie provided the others play in the order of merit approved by the CAP.

Unless the Championships Director is notified otherwise in writing at least **one hour** before the scheduled start of a Tie or within 10 minutes of completion of the previous Tie (whichever is the later), Managers shall be deemed to have selected their top players. The CAP reserves the right to allow changes to player nominations after the deadline for each Tie in exceptional circumstances.

7. A Team Manager may request permission from the CAP to replace a member of his squad at any time after the Final Submission Date and through the Championships. Such permission will only be given if the reason is considered by the CAP to be legitimate (e.g. illness, injury or *force majeure*) and provided that the replacement player is accepted by the CAP as being of **lower** strength than all members of the squad previously nominated.

The Championships Director will advise all Team Managers in writing if a player is being replaced. Any appeal against the decision to replace or not replace a player must be made within **two hours** to the CAP.

All player privileges and facilities will be passed on to any replacement player, on arrival at the Championships, by the player being replaced and the replaced player may not rejoin his squad during the Championships.

A Team Manager may, at any time during the Championships, appeal to the CAP if he has evidence that a player, in an opposing squad, is likely to compete, or has competed when unfit.

If this appeal is upheld, then the player in question may not be nominated to compete in any Tie until approved by the CAP and appropriate action may be taken against the squad concerned.
