CATEGORIES

The HEAD Danish Junior Open 2011 is open to players of any nationality under the age of 13, 15, 17 and 19 on the final day of the tournament provided the player is not banned under the [ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines](#) section C.4.e, section E.4.a or section E.4.b.

There will be a maximum of 32 draw per category, with the possibility to expand specific categories if maximum draw is not reached in other categories.

A player can enter only one category.

TRANSPORT

For those acquired transportation through the entry, transportation by arrangement will be provided from and to Herlev train station or Copenhagen airport (arrival/departure point) according to the entry form.

There will be a bus shuttle service between hotel and venue.

DRAWS AND SEEDINGS

The seeding and preliminary schedules for the first match will be published on djo.dsquf2.dk, at least 7 days before the start of the event. The seeding will be carried out using the ESF Junior Rankings valid at the tournament closing date, in accordance with the [ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines](#) section D.

MATCHES

All matches will be played as best of five games with PAR 11 scoring to 2 clear points.

All players will be guaranteed a minimum of three scheduled matches.

All positions in the categories will be played out.

ESF approved balls will be used in all matches.

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.



HEAD HEAD HEAD



Wearing of approved eye protection on court is mandatory. Players will not be allowed to compete without approved eye protection. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the quality of the product is satisfactory for the purpose. Check WSF website (www.worldsquash.org) for approved eye guards.

PRIZES

There will be trophies and prize money awarded in the U19 boys and girls categories. In all other categories, there will be trophies and gift prizes.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organizers nor the ESF or WSF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event. Players must arrange their own insurance.

WEB PUBLISHING

The Danish Junior Open will publish draws, results, photos of players at venue and hotel. As this is part of the Danish Junior Open tournament rules, the organizer will deem that players and their parents have accepted these regulations by entering the tournament.

GUIDELINES

This event complies with the European Squash Federation Junior Circuit Guidelines – a copy of which is available on the European Squash Federation website at www.europeansquash.com. All participating member nations should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

ESF PENALTIES from [ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines](#) section E.

§E.4.a If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office no later than two days after the final day of the tournament (email: info@europeansquash.com; fax +44 1675 443440). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the tournament finishing.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

§E.4.b If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

§E.4.c If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to the ESF office within two days of the tournament finishing. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
